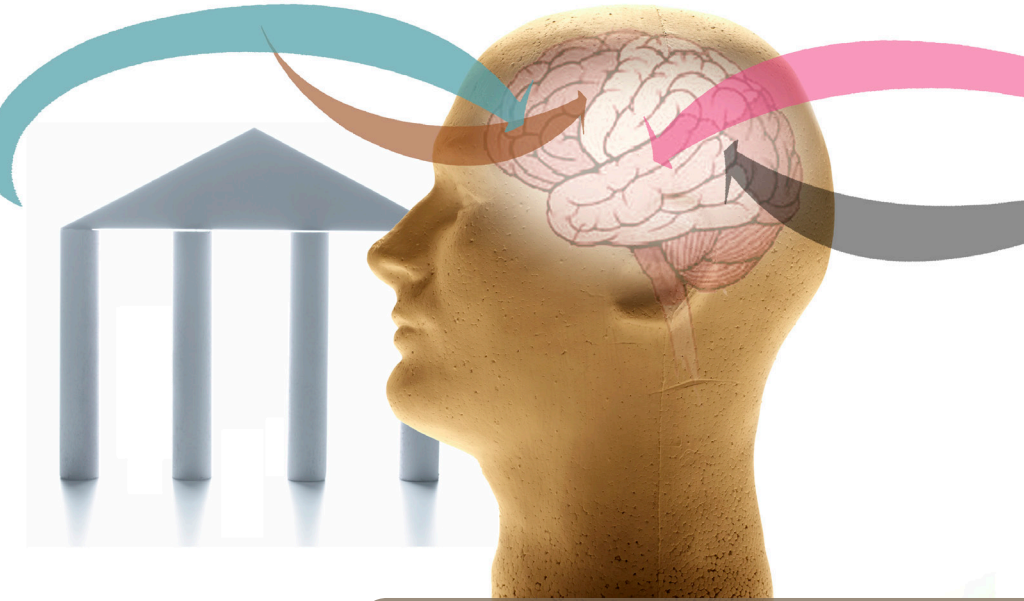

HILL** is founding director of the Institute for Law and Rationality, associate director of the Institute for Law and Economics, and an affiliated faculty member of the University's Center for Cognitive Sciences. She teaches corporate law, mergers and acquisitions, contracts, and a seminar in law and economics. She completed a B.A. and M.A. in philosophy at the University of Chicago; a J.D., summa cum laude, at American University Washington College of Law; and an LL.M. and J.S.D. at Columbia University School of Law, where she was an Olin Fellow.

Professor Hill joined the Law School faculty in 2006. She has taught at the law schools of Boston University, George Mason University, Northwestern University, Georgetown University (where she was a Sloan Visiting Professor), and Chicago-Kent (where she was a Freehling Scholar). Her research interests include corporate governance, capital structure, structured finance, secured debt, contract theory, law and language, behavioral economics, and rating agencies (about which she has been interviewed on television and radio). Her work has been published in law reviews and finance and psychology journals, featured on business blogs, and included in three annual edited volumes of *Securities Law Review*. She won the *Queen's Law Journal's* 2007 David Watson Memorial Award for significant legal scholarship for "The Law and Economics of Identity."
