He has written numerous books and articles on law and economics and currently is editor-in-chief of the *Review of Law and Economics* and the *Supreme Court Economic Review*. He serves on the board of editors of the International Review of Law and Economics, the *Journal of Public Choice*, the *American Journal of Comparative Law*, and the Social Sciences Research Network.
