

**Dennis Nguyen**, 41, is the Chairman and Co-Founder of New Asia Partners, a Minneapolis and Shanghai-based private equity investment group. He is responsible for the overall management of the group. Mr. Nguyen is an adjunct professor at the University of Minnesota Law School teaching courses in financial markets analysis and investment banking/private equity/hedge funds.

Mr. Nguyen was formerly a director of Wuyi International Pharmaceuticals Investment Co., Ltd, a Fujian, China-based pharmaceutical company listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange (code: 1889.HK) and Sino Environmental Technology Group Ltd, a Fujian, China-based environmental waste management company listed on the Singapore Stock Exchange (code: Y62.SI). He also served as the Vice Chairman of China Huiyin Group Ltd (predecessor company of Huiyin Household Appliances (1280.HK)), a Jiangsu, China-based household appliance and consumer electronics retail chain store operator.

Mr. Nguyen was previously Vice President of Daiwa Securities SMBC, where he headed all Greater China investment banking activities. As the Associate Director of Equity Capital Markets at Crédit Agricole Indosuez, he was responsible for the Taiwan/HK markets. Mr. Nguyen worked for Citigroup's M&A department and the management consulting and treasury groups at Northern Telecom.

Mr. Nguyen is a member of the National Committee on US China Relations and the Minneapolis Club. He is a trustee of the University of California, Irvine (UCI) Foundation Board of Trustees. He also is a member of the University of Minnesota (UMN) Law School Dean's Advisory Council, the UMN Law School Board of Advisors and the UCI Alumni Association Board of Directors, respectively. Mr. Nguyen chairs the UCI School of Humanities Dean's Leadership Council. He previously served on the Johns Hopkins University/Nanjing University Advisory Council.

Mr. Nguyen was honored as the "2010 Distinguished Alumnus" by the UCI Alumni Association and the School of Humanities. He was the featured speaker of the 2009 UCI School of Humanities Commencement Ceremony. Mr. Nguyen has spoken on the "Ramifications of the Rise of the Chinese Middle Class and its Effect on US China Economic Relations" to the National Committee on US China Relations. He has appeared numerous times on CNBC's Squawk Box, discussing the private equity industry in Asia.

Mr. Nguyen holds a M.B.A. from the University of Chicago Booth School of Business, joint M.A. in International Studies from Johns Hopkins University-School of Advanced International Studies/Nanjing University, a Juris Doctor from the University of Minnesota Law School and a double B.A. in Economics and Chinese Literature from the University of California, Irvine.

Fluent in Mandarin Chinese and Vietnamese, Mr. Nguyen lives in Minneapolis, MN and has three children.
