JOHN H. MATHESON is an internationally recognized expert in the area of corporate and business law and is co-director of the Center for Business Law. Since joining the Law School faculty in 1982, he has taught in China, Germany, the Netherlands, and Lithuania. He has received the annual Stanley V. Kinyon Outstanding Teaching and Counseling Award five times and a National Burton Award for Excellence in Legal Writing for a co-authored article in 2007. In 2008, he was

the first Law School professor to receive the University-wide Award for Outstanding Contributions to Postbaccalaureate, Graduate and Professional Education and was inducted into the Academy of Distinguished Teachers.

Professor Matheson received his B.S. from Illinois State University and his J.D. from Northwestern University School of Law, after which he practiced law in Chicago. He is of counsel to the Minneapolis law firm of Kaplan, Strangis and Kaplan, where he specializes in corporate governance counseling, mergers and acquisitions, and securities law matters. He is a member of the American Law Institute and is profiled in *Who's Who in America*.
