



# Declaration of Law Minor

A law minor is available to both master's (M.A. and M.S.) and doctoral students and is individually tailored to academic interests. Use this form to notify the Law School of your intent to earn a Law Minor. Review your major field's student handbook and confer with your faculty adviser and Director of Graduate Studies (DGS) to ensure your plan fulfills minimum graduate education and program requirements. In addition to this declaration form, graduate students must also register their minor on the Graduate Degree plan with the Graduate Student Services and Progress office in 160 Williamson Hall and consult with the Law School's Director of Graduate Studies about appropriate courses. **A master's minor requires 6 law credits; a doctoral minor requires 12 law credits.**

### Important Notices to Student:

- *Course Availability:* Students may seek enrollment in Law School courses, other than experiential learning courses (7000-level). Enrollment in courses depends on space availability and may require individual approval by the faculty member teaching the course. - *Law School Honor Code:* All students enrolled for Law School courses are subject to the [Law School Honor Code](#). Violations may result in grade reductions. Detailed information about the Honor Code is available on the Law School website.
- *Effect of Enrollment:* Credit for law courses is not transferrable to the Juris Doctor, LL.M. or M.S.P.L. programs at the University of Minnesota Law School and is not transferrable to most other law schools.
